LIVESTOCK ENTRY DATE: Thursday, June 11, 8:00 p.m.

JUDGING: 4-H judging which will start Friday, June 12, at 8:00 a.m. They will be judging in the following order: Dairy, Beef, Sheep and Hogs. Open class judging will be on Friday, June 12, following 4-H and FFA judging and North Dakota point system on Sat., June 13, 8:00 am.

STALLS: Will be allotted on first come basis.

GENERAL RULES: In the event of less than three entries in a class, the judges are not required to give a blue ribbon if they feel the entry is not blue ribbon quality. In all classes of livestock there must be competition by two bonafide breeders or first place money will be withheld and second prize money awarded as first prize money. Individual animals shown in all of the groups and herd classes listed below must have been entered and shown in one of the following classes for single animals. All animals must be registered as the property of the exhibitor in the records.

All animals exhibited as a registered animal must be registered in the exhibitor's name with the respective breed association. If the registration does not show ownership by the exhibitor, the animal must be shown in the grade class.
